Notice of Public Hearing for the Purposes of Considering the Establishment of a  
Joint Fire District**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT pursuant to Town Law Section 189-a, a Joint Public Hearing of the Town Board of the Town of Corning and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Corning will be held on **Wednesday January 30, 2019 commencing at 6:30 PM** at Corning Town Hall, 20 South Maple Street Corning, New York 14830 for the purposes of considering the establishment of a joint fire district in those areas currently comprised of the Town of Corning General Fire Protection District (FD384) (including the area therein served by the North Corning Volunteer Fire Department, Inc.), the East Corning Fire Protection District (FD383), and the Village of South Corning and whether the formation of a joint fire district is in the public interest for the continued provision of fire protection and emergency services within those affected portions of the Town of Corning and Village of South Corning; and to hear all persons interested in the subject.

The boundaries of the proposed joint fire district being generally described as follows: that area within the Town of Corning currently designated and commonly known and referred to as the Town of Corning General Fire Protection District (FD384) (including the area served by the North Corning Volunteer Fire Department, Inc.), the East Corning Fire Protection District (FD383), and the Village of South Corning, with the boundaries of the proposed joint fire district being the same as the boundaries of the entirety of the Town of Corning, excepting therefrom the Village of Riverside, the City of Corning, and the Gibson Fire District (FD1).

The objects for which it is proposed that a joint fire district be established are to provide for a uniform, equitable, and stable system for the governance and funding of fire protection and emergency services and the purposes for which it is proposed that a joint fire district be established is to ensure the continued provision of fire protection and emergency services by the dedicated volunteers serving the community by establishing a board of fire commissioners of the joint fire district to serve as the authority having jurisdiction over the provision of such services and operations as provided by law.
